Rebates Available

Marion County residents who own a single-family dwelling built before **1995** and businesses that are planning on replacing their existing high-flow toilets [3.5 gallons per flush (gpf) or greater] with a high-efficiency toilet using **1.28 gpf** or less or a WaterSense® labeled toilet can receive a rebate.

Marion County Utilities customers are eligible for a rebate of up to \$100 for the first toilet and a rebate of up to \$80 for the second toilet as a credit on their MCU utility bill. *Limit two toilets per household.*

Non-Utility Customers of Unincorporated Marion County are eligible for a rebate of up to \$100 for the first toilet and a rebate of up to \$80 for the second toilet. *Limit two toilets per household.*

How Do I Qualify?

- You must be a resident of Unincorporated Marion County in a home or a business within a structure built in 1995 or before.
- New toilet(s) must be 1.28 gallons/flush or less or a WaterSense® labeled toilet(s).
- Applications must be completed and replacement toilet must be purchased and installed between 10/1/21 and 8/31/22.
- Old toilet(s) must NOT be re-installed at any location, and must be destroyed and/ or disposed of properly.

How Do I Apply?

1. Complete this form and submit it, using the information above.
2. If you qualify for the program, an application number will be issued to you, allowing for the installation of new toilet(s) and submission of required documents. Rebate funding is limited. Rebates are issued on a first-come, first-serve basis. Random installation verification inspections are conducted. Please anticipate a call to schedule an inspection.
3. After installation, submit the following **required documents** by mail, email or fax to the contact above. **Be sure to include your application number.**
 - a. Pictures of the embossed numbers in the tank of the old toilet and the new toilet(s) in place
 - b. Your purchase receipts
 - c. Plumber information (name, address, phone number, and license number), if applicable
4. No more than 2 new toilets per residence can qualify for this rebate program.
